## Certificate in the bag: Five EMG trainees successfully trained

Wenden, 04 March 2022: They have successfully completed their vocational training at EMG Automation GmbH: Jean-Lennart Fazlioglu (electronics technician for industrial engineering), Magdalena Libera (technical product designer), Elias Schade (cutting machine operator), Jan Schneider (mechatronics technician) and Norman Senger (cutting machine operator). After the five apprentices had passed their final examination before the Siegen Chamber of Industry and Commerce, they were now presented with their final certificates by representatives of the management, the works council and the training management. In recognition of their good performance, they also received gift vouchers and a souvenir photo of their first day of training at EMG.

CEO Dr. Rolf Merte explains: "I would like to congratulate our trainees on the successful completion of their training. They are now top trained professionals. That is good for us and the region. That's why the issue of training is a major concern for me, and one that I, as a member of the Board of Management, am pushing forward with full conviction."

The training lasted three and a half years. After basic training in the company's own training workshop, the apprentices went through various production areas as well as specialised courses. EMG takes on all five graduates as permanent employees.

EMG has been providing training in the region for more than 75 years. Since then, around 1,300 young people have completed their training here. In addition to industrial and commercial training opportunities, EMG has its own training workshop, annual internships abroad in England and Ireland, and regular apprentice trips. EMG currently employs 36 apprentices. The next training year will start on 01 September 2022.
